Volunteer Role Description

Disability Action Haringey (DAH) was formed in early 2020 with the aim of supporting disabled people in the London Borough of Haringey maintain their independence and freedom. We are committed to the social model of disability and building a society that accepts and accommodates everyone. As a D/deaf and Disabled Persons' Organisation, our services will always be centred on the demands of the service users themselves, which leads us to take a holistic approach to support.

Our services include Direct Payment Support Services & matching Personal (care) Assistants, Peer Support Services, Access to Activity for Health & Wellbeing and Facilitating Co-Design & Co-Production initiatives.

DBS: DBS required (undertaken by Age UK York).

Role purpose

To act as access points to DAH services and to inform the strategic development of community services and projects across Haringey.

Personal qualities and experience

Community Outreach volunteers are friendly and patient. They understand the needs of the D/deaf and Disabled community and are able to empathise with them. They demonstrate strong listening and communication skills. Some experience within a similar environment or Voluntary & Community Sector setting is useful. Reliability is key. Volunteers must be willing to work within guidelines and always follow confidentiality policies.

- Access training and development as appropriate.
