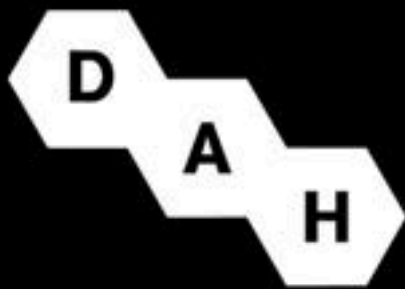

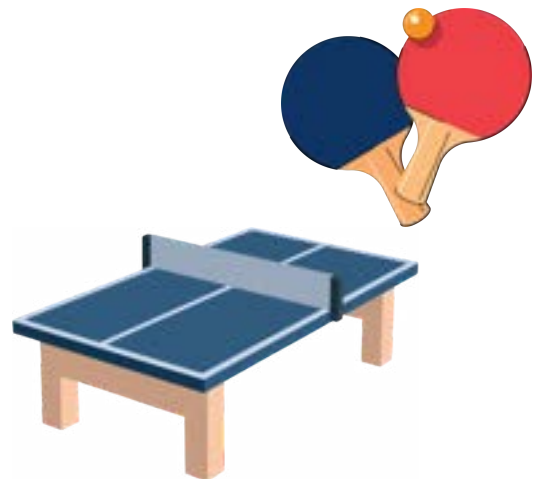

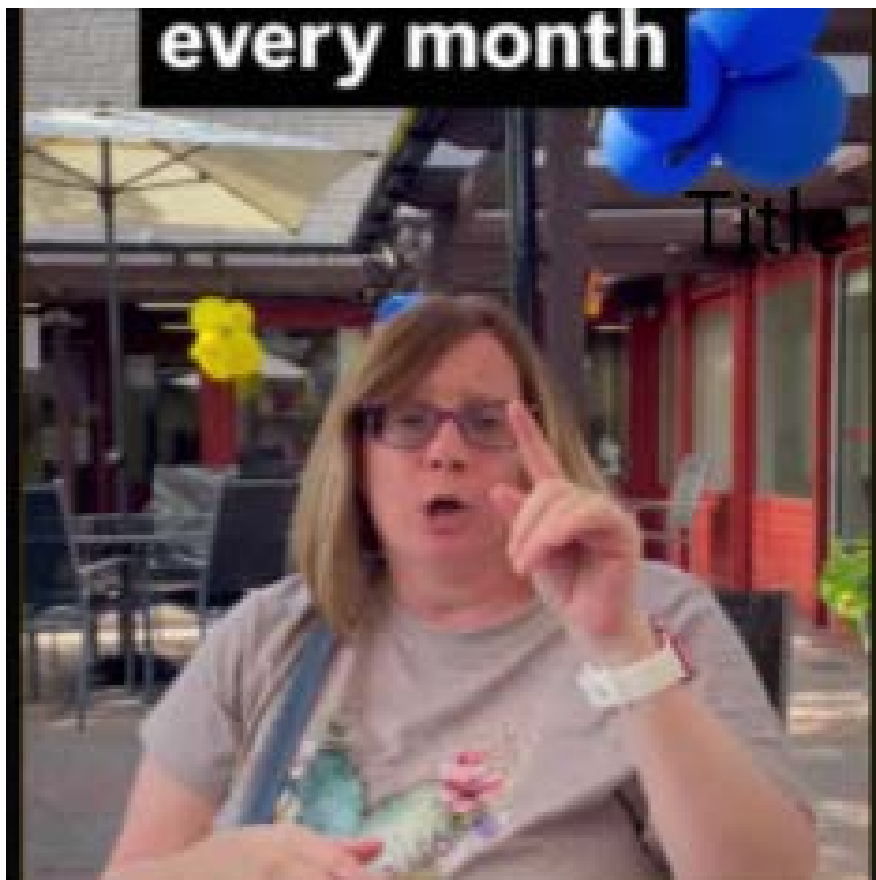

Direct Payments gives you more choice and control over your care by letting you select your own support. Our staff can explain how Direct Payments work and help you get the service you want.

DAH offers comprehensive advice and support, including a peer support programme where you can learn from other disabled residents. We also advise on employing a personal (care) assistant—whether you're new to Direct Payments or already using them. If you're considering Direct Payments or just want to know more, we're here to help!

The Renters' Rights Act: a turning point for London's renters, if enforced properly



From 2021 to 2024, more than one in three London councils did not take legal action against a single landlord who broke the law. At the same time, renting in London became much more expensive, with people spending on average 42% of their income on rent.

Generation Rent Chief Executive Ben Twomey spoke to the London Assembly Housing Committee on 20 January 2026 about how the Renters' Rights Act should be introduced and monitored in London.

He said the new law could make a big difference for renters, but only if councils have the staff and resources to enforce it properly and make landlords follow the rules. He called on local councils to build stronger enforcement teams to hold landlords accountable.
